Given the make-up of the Grand Council, only those students who are the Children or Grand Children of an Active or Retired member of one of the Member Associations of the Grand Council will be eligible to submit an application. Further, the student must demonstrate an interest in Community Service to their community.

Academic requirements for applicants are: a 90 average. The applicant also must submit their SAT/ACT scores.

The deadline for submitting applications is May 22, 2019. Award recipients will be announced by July 1, 2019 and the scholarship will be awarded on July 8, 2019, German-American Night at Eisenhower Park, at the Grand Council Picnic.

Applications are to be mailed so as to be received no later than May 22, 2019. (No applications received after May 22, 2019 will be considered.)
